

1. HOW TO ENTER

To be eligible for one of the 10 stay-in-school scholarships, participants must visit the Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal website between March 1 and May 13, 2011 at http://www.ccmmt.qc.ca/fr/lachambre-Je_m_implique-Operation_Retour_a_l_ecole_evaluation_eleves, complete the speaker evaluation form and answer the question, indicating their name and the name of their teacher.

Only one entry per presentation a student attends will be accepted. Anyone who enters for more presentations than attended will be automatically disqualified.

To be valid, entry forms must be received by email by May 13, 2011 at 5 p.m.

Entry forms become the property of the Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal and are not returned to participants. The chances of winning a prize are directly related to the number of entries received.

No purchase required.

2. ELIGIBILITY

Participants must reside in Canada, be students and have attended at least one presentation as part of Operation Back to School in 2011. Directors, officers and employees of the **Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal** are not eligible for the contest.

3. AWARD OF PRIZES

On May 16, 2011 at approximately 9:15 a.m., a random draw will be held at the Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal from among all the entries received. The first ten (10) participants drawn will be declared winners of a prize, provided they fulfill the conditions described in these rules.

Participants drawn at random will be contacted by phone through their teacher within seven (7) days of the draw and must claim the prize according to the **Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal's** instructions within a maximum of five (5) days from the date they are first contacted. Prizes will be explained to students and their parents, and parents must sign a document agreeing that their child receive the scholarship. The winners will be invited to the closing evening for Operation Back to School on June 29 at 5 p.m. where the scholarships will be awarded. If the prize is not claimed within this timeframe or if a participant drawn at random cannot be reached within seven (7) days of the draw, a new draw will take place.

4. DESCRIPTION OF PRIZES

The first four (4) people drawn will win a \$2,500 stay-in-school scholarship. The prize amount will be placed in a Universitas fund in the winner's name. The six (6) other people drawn will each win a \$1,250 scholarship, which will be placed in a Universitas fund in the winner's name.

5. GENERAL RULES

5.1 To be declared a winner, participants drawn at random must have respectfully answered each of the questions on the online conference speaker evaluation form.

5.2 Winners must sign a document attesting to their eligibility as specified in paragraph 2 of these rules and releasing the **Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal**, as well as its directors, officers and employees, from any liability with regard to damages or a loss resulting from entering this contest or from the awarding, acceptance or use of this prize.

5.3 The prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be exchanged for cash, sold or transferred. No substitutions will be allowed.

5.4 Refusal to accept the prize releases the **Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal**, as well as its directors, officers and employees, from any liability or obligation with regard to the winner.

5.5 False declarations by a participant will result in automatic disqualification from the contest.

5.6 The **Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal**, as well as its directors, officers and employees, assumes no liability resulting from losses, delays, address errors on mail or email received, printing errors, technical, computer or phone malfunctions, software or hardware failures, fraudulent calls or any other error.

5.7 The **Board of Trade of Metropolitan Montreal**, as well as its directors, officers and employees, accepts no liability of any sort in the event that its inability to act results in a fact or situation that is unforeseeable or beyond its control, including strike, lock-out or any other labour conflict in its establishment or the establishments of organizations or businesses whose services are used for this contest.

5.8 Personal information, such as the name and the teacher's name, is collected solely for the purposes of the administration of this contest and is not used for any other purpose without consent. In providing this information, participants consent to its use for the purposes indicated.
